



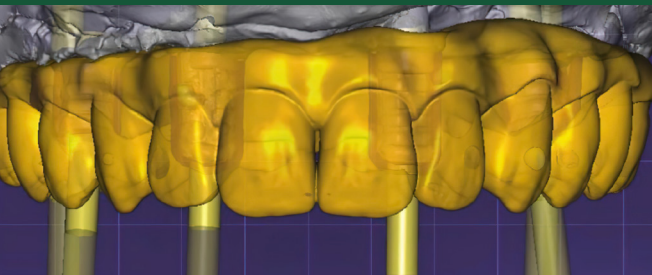

THE COURSE IS DIVIDED INTO 4 MAIN SECTIONS

1. Records, Scanning, and Acquisition.
2. Digital Treatment Planning, Immediate Loading Protocols for Digital Cases.
3. Digital Restoration Design.
4. Fabrication, Characterization for Immediate and Final Restorations.

The course is limited to 4 lab technicians. Each day is mixed between hands on experiences and short, condensed lectures. There are demonstrations of live patient scanning with intraoral scanners, photogrammetry scanners, facial scanners, and cone beam radiology.

Complete lab integration and training from a lab technician's perspective is crucial to any full arch practice. There are multiple modules everyday that are taught by experts in their fields. Each attendee takes home a binder that contains a "cookbook" for applying the workflow and implementing what they learned. Consulting and support is available through our dental lab after the course to help technicians apply what they learned and put it into action.

CONGRATULATIONS! You are about to embark on a fun and informative week at our office and lab. Please take a few moments to read through this information packet and survey.

THINGS TO NOTE BEFORE YOUR VISIT:

- Each day starts at 8 am.
- Lunch will be provided by us. Please let us know if you have any dietary restrictions.
- The day will end approximately at 6 pm.
- Feel free to bring cameras, video equipment, take notes, and ask questions. This is meant to provide all the skills and knowledge to do full arch digital and analog cases in house. There is a lot of information to absorb and you will forget a lot. We are always here for follow up questions.
- We will be doing real cases on real patients. They will have been informed that Dr. Dunlop is doing a training course. Feel free to interact and ask them questions as is appropriate.
- Since this is a clinical course with real patients, dress in scrubs or appropriate clinical attire. This applies to staff that might be attending as well. No open toed shoes, shorts, hats, jeans, or sports attire.
- The day is scattered with patients who will be at various stages of their reconstruction. We will do our best to create a clear analog and digital workflow, but you will likely see many steps out of order on different patients.
- We occasionally have our own film crew on site to document training aspects of the course and do on-site interviews. Please let us know in advance if you do not want to be involved in documenting the education experience.
